Handed to the Parish Priest, Rev. Fr. Nelson Chitty on 25th March 2022, Feast of the Annunciation, was a lost and found treasure after 15 years. The prayers of the parishioners of the Church of the Holy Name of Jesus, Balik Pulau were finally answered when the Seventh Station of the 14-Piece Way of the Cross was returned by Archbishop Julian Leow to Bishop Sebastian Francis recently during a meeting in Penang. It was returned by an antique buyer from Kuala Lumpur who upon discovering that it was stolen in 2007 from the Balik Pulau Church, handed it over to Archbishop Julian Leow.
