I pray you are coping well thus far by the Grace of God. Here I wish to share with you additional notifications and updates in our diocese. The updates will be provided periodically through this same means from my office.

Item 1

The Diocese of Penang has officially set up a Diocesan ZOOM account mainly for the use of the Bishop's Office, Diocesan Committees, Diocesan Institutions, and Diocesan Ministries.
